## 1. Introduction:

The Association De Fabula—Genoa Italy—on the occasion of VIII Biennial 2011 advertises the 1<sup>st</sup> international competition for the creation of handmade work using embroidery and lace techniques.

Theme: Bag – Purse - Wallet

The competition is aimed at all artists of every country, regardless of sex, age, race or religion.

The amount to pay as a contribution to expenses is 15 euros.

## 2. Works:

Each artist must exhibit a personal, hand-made work, hitherto unpublished, displaying techniques of embroidery and lace of traditional type and/or with mixed techniques.

Work must be no bigger than the maximum size 50x60 cm.s

## 3. Exclusion of works:

Works will be automatically excluded and returned at the expense of the sender

Work which does not conform to the size in point 2

Work which arrives after the deadline in point 4

Work which has been exhibited at other events

#### 4. Participation deadline:

Candidates must send applications and entrance fee to Association De Fabula or e-mail [defabula@email.it](mailto:defabula@email.it) by 31/10/2010 a colour photo of the work and/or its detail in digital format.jpg with a short design by e-mail or on cd must arrive by 31/03/2011. This will allow us to prepare a catalogue costing about 30 euros which interested people will be able to book in advance.

Work is to be sent at the expense of the sender by 31/07/2011 complete with all information for purposes of return. On the package please write the following words: "Work destined for a competition without commercial value."

Works will be shown during the biennial which takes place in the month of October 2011 and will be returned within 30 days by post and charged to the addressee.

Information will be treated under the rules of the competition of the D.Lgs.n.106/2003.

#### 5. Jury:

The jury consisting of experts in embroidery and lace and a journalist in design will give its final judgement. The winner will be officially announced at the VIII Biennial De Fabula.

All artists will be given recognition. We understand that works submitted are for exhibition and promotional purposes.
