On the occasion of the 2011 De Fabula biennial edition, we have just started to work on the project regarding the interpretation of the picture "The three ages of woman" by G. Klimt.

We want many countries of the world to be represented with their traditional laces or embroideries making little parts of that picture.

In order to show the tight connection between art and artisans, we have also asked a famous Italian painter, Walter Di Giusto, to interpret a part of "The three ages of woman" and assemble it with bobbing lace and embroidery.

If you agree to collaborate with us, we'll send you a cardboard template, some kind of threads and full information to make a rectangular shaped bobbin lace piece. (about 6 cm x 12 cm)

I remind you that all pieces must be interpretations not copies, so we'd like you to make your own artefact using the best of your capacities and imagination, as well.
